### Travelling Around

- Where possible get door to door lifts from family or taxi
- Let someone at home know your journey arrangements.
- Be aware of your surroundings, think safe places where there are shops, good lighting, activity etc
- Get to know where your local **Help Point Schemes** are



- Walk **confidently** in well lit areas, avoid dark shortcuts.
- Never accept lifts from strangers or someone you don't know well.
- Safest place on the Bus is at the bottom near the driver.
- Walk in sensible attire and clothing.

### Personal Property.

- Register all expensive items with **www.immobilise.com** and keep them hidden.
- Don't listen to music, if you absolutely have to; keep it hidden.
- Keep phones on silent or vibrate when you are out and about
- Be careful where you answer your phone, don't be an advert.
- Set your phone so that it can only be opened with a pin
- The safest bags have a long strap worn across your body. Wear with the entrance facing your body and if possible worn under your coat.
- If threatened for money, property hand it over
- Trust your instincts, if you feel unsafe create distance get away.
