

We have much to celebrate from recent weeks, beginning with the year 11 December exam.



The theme this year was 'fragments'. This will count as 25% of students' final grade. Well done for all your hard work and below are a few examples of the excellent work produced.

Homework is a vital part of students' development and independence and every piece of homework counts towards students' final grade in all key stages. Below are a few outstanding examples from year 11.




What is the best way to layout the composition of your page? This can add many marks to your final grade.




Students are measured against age expected progress. We have 5 levels of progress and these are. Below age expected progress.

Towards age expected progress.



National expected level of progress.

Examples of excellent year 8 and 9 homework and classwork.


Students have been studying the difficult theme of portraiture, working from first hand.






## Current exhibitions


