Dear Students, Parents and Carers,

I am pleased to announce that The Penridge Suite, N11 1NL has been booked for the Year 11 students' Prom. This event will take place on **Tuesday 2nd July 2019**.

Students should make their own way to The Penridge Suite for 7pm, **last entry will be 8pm**. Once students have arrived, they are not allowed to leave as they will not be re-admitted.

Students will be dismissed at 11pm and will be expected to make their own arrangements to get home.

A buffet menu will be provided and no alcohol will be served to students. The cost also includes one visit to the photobooth. However, as part of our rewards programme, students that meet specific reward targets will have **unlimited access** to the photobooth.

## Prom Passport

All Students have been issued with a Prom Passport, where they can collect points for attending revision, improved attendance, full uniform and excellent behaviour and attitude.

Once your child has obtained 200 points they will have enough points to come to Prom, at which point we will add the payment to your ParentPay.

**The cost of the Prom is £35.00** which will be added to your ParentPay account for you to pay and complete the consent form. The payment has been set up so that you can pay variable amounts e.g. £10 monthly or you can pay in larger instalments. However, we do ask that we receive full payment by **31<sup>st</sup> May 2019**. Cash and cheques will not be accepted. If you do not have your log in details, you can get them from the finance office.

For the trip to be a safe experience for all involved, the school has particular requirements regarding behaviour which are detailed overleaf in a 'code of conduct'.

Acceptance on this trip is currently provisional; should any concerns be raised about behaviour or attitude during the course of the exam period and prior to the departure date, your place may be cancelled with no refund of the payment.

We look forward to commemorating the end of their five years at Chace, celebrating our year group and saying farewell to this part of their journey.
