

## **Year 7 Catch Up Premium 2019-20**

### **What is the Year 7 Catch-Up Premium?**

Since September 2012 the Government has allocated extra funding to schools for 'Catch-up' strategies and interventions to enable schools to provide extra support and focused interventions in Mathematics and Reading to address low attainment. This literacy and numeracy catch-up premium provides additional funding to support students who did not achieve the expected standard in reading and/or mathematics in the KS2 SATS.

### **Overview 2018-19**

We received £16,833 in funding for additional literacy and numeracy catch up support for the 58 students in Year 7 below the expected standard in Reading and/or Mathematics. We have 22 students who arrived below the expected standard in both subjects.

The funding contributed towards 4 days of HLTA and teacher time per week to deliver the following interventions:

#### **English**

'Catch up' literacy programme (1:1 personalised intervention)

English intervention

Reading groups

#### **Maths**

'Catch up' numeracy programme (1:1 personalised intervention)

'Spring Board' Maths

As there are such a large number of students who arrived below the expected standard in either Reading or Maths or both, the support was targeted at the students with the greatest need and at those for whom it would have the largest impact.

#### **KS3 Assessment**

At KS3 we no longer use levels to measure pupil attainment. Instead, teachers assess the students three times per year and allocate them a band based on their performance.

The Bands are:

Band 1 – Working significantly above National Expectation – progressing towards GCSE grades 8/9

Band 2 - Working above National Expectation – progressing towards GCSE grades 7/6

Band 3 – Working at National Expectation – progressing towards GCSE grades 4/5

Band 4 –Working towards National Expectation – progressing towards GCSE grade 3

Band 5 – Working significantly below National Expectation – progressing towards GCSE grades 2/1

Their progress during Year 7 is shown below using our KS3 banding system:

**How will the funding will be used in 2019-20?**

We will receive funding for this additional literacy and numeracy catch up support in February 2020. The identified students for Catch Up will receive a variety of interventions this academic year including:

**Year 7 English interventions:**

‘Catch up’ literacy programme

GROW – intensive reading intervention

IDL Literacy

Reading groups

**Year 7 Maths interventions:**

‘Catch up’ numeracy programme

Spring board Maths

IDL Numeracy

We will continue to use our banding system to measure the progress of the targeted students.
