WELCOME TO CHACE

We are delighted that your child has been offered a place at Chace Community School and are looking forward to welcoming him/her in September 2019. We are keen to build a positive supportive relationship with you so that your child settles in quickly to be a successful learner at Chace.

We are really proud of all the work that we have been undertaking to improve the experience of our learners. Improvements to teaching led to significant improvements to our GCSE results last summer – the most improved school in Enfield – and we expect these to improve further in 2019 and beyond.

Changing schools can be a time of uncertainty, but it is also exciting, challenging and full of opportunity. As Year 7 approaches we have planned opportunities to meet with you and the children to explain some of our procedures and give you an opportunity to meet your child's tutor. Please note the dates and times in your diary now:

- **Thursday 27th June at 6:00pm** there will be an Induction Evening **for parents only**.
- **Thursday 4th July at 9:00am – 12:15pm** there will be an Induction Morning **for students only**.

We have contacted primary schools to ensure that they are aware of this date and your child will be allowed out of their primary school at this time.

Year 7 students will start on Wednesday, 4th September 2019
8:30am – 3:10pm

The first few days of secondary school in September provide essential induction and we would ask you not to organise family holidays at this time.

At Chace we share a commitment to learning and are determined to be the best we can be. With this in mind we encourage students to engage with some "Extended Learning" over the summer holiday and expect all students to submit work. Your support with this is appreciated. Details of this year's theme will be given to students during their visit on 4th July 2019.

We recommend that you log on to our website regularly to learn about life at Chace and find information regarding your child's transition. All transition documents and forms will be available on the Chace website www.chace.enfield.sch.uk for you to view, download and complete. You can find them under **ABOUT US → Admissions and Transition → Transition September 2019**. We will write to you in the near future to explain which documents you must complete.

As part of our transition programme we will be offering a range of after school activities in the Summer term for your child to take part in. Our transition trip to Tolmers will take place on **Friday, 13th September to Saturday, 14th September** and a full programme of all events will be available from the school website in due course.
