

KS5 CURRICULUM: FRENCH (YEAR 13)

Overview: Year 13 will continue to explore aspects of French speaking society by focusing on issues and trends. Students will be using a range of transferable skills including communication, critical thinking, research skills and creativity, which are valuable to the individual and society. They will also extend their cultural knowledge through literary texts, films and an individual research project.

Spring 2	Teenagers, the right to vote and political commitment. Film study & Speaking- IRP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discuss arguments relating to the vote and examine the French political system and its evolution. Form and use the passive voice. 	End of Module assessment (w/b 1st March 2021)
Summer 1	Demonstrations, strikes: Who holds the power? Film study & Speaking- IRP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Understand the important role of unions. Talk about strikes and protests and consider different methods of protesting. Understand and use subject and object pronouns. 	End of year exams- Speaking
Summer 2	Politics and immigration Film study & Speaking- IRP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Consider the viewpoints of political parties regarding immigration. Form and use the future perfect and the conditional perfect. 	Paper 1- Listening/Reading and Writing exam Paper 2- Writing exam
