

KS4 CURRICULUM: SPANISH (YEAR 10)

Overview

In Spanish you will learn about: Year 10 Spanish takes into account prior learning from year 7-9 whilst deepening their language skills at KS4. You will learn to understand longer and passages on familiar themes and learn to use the Future, Imperfect and Perfect tenses whilst revisiting the use of regular and some irregular verbs in tenses learnt at KS3. Students will be developing their Speaking and Writing skills to a higher level than used before. They will also be developing their cultural awareness through the various Modules studied at GCSE and have the chance to speak about these in their Speaking assessments.

Autumn 2	Module 3: My relationships and technology	Describing family relationships and other friendships. Describing other people (Physically and their characteristics). Being able to describe how they use their phones and social media. Discussing reading (books or tablets). Using Ser and Estar correctly and how to use the Present Continuous.	Vocabulary test every fortnight. Grammar tests. Translation tests. One long writing test. Assessment week (w/b 9th Nov 2020) Writing and Listening based on Modules 1-2
Spring 1	Module 4: Free time activities and influences	Discussing TV programmes and films. Talking about Sports and exercise. Looking at celebrities as role models and others who inspire you. Using Sueldo + Infinitive structure. Using both the imperfect and perfect tenses. Using the He/She/It form in our work to discuss other people.	Vocabulary test every fortnight. Grammar tests. Translation tests. One long writing test. End of Module Assessment (w/b 5 th Jan 2021) Based on Modules 1-3 (Speaking role play and Reading)
Spring 2	Module 5: Where I live	Being able to describe the area that I live in (what it looks like, places there are etc). Discussing activities that I can do in my area as well as the advantages/disadvantages of where I live. Using Se puede/No se puede. Learning how to use the Future tense and learning how to use <i>tan and tanto</i>.	Vocabulary test every fortnight. Grammar tests. Translation tests. One long writing test. End of module assessment (w/b 1 st March 2021) Based on Modules 3-4 (Speaking photo card and Writing)
Summer 1	Module 6: Where I live/ Developing speaking skills	Describe a visit to another place in the past tense. Being able to refer to events in the past/present and future.	Vocabulary test every fortnight. Grammar tests. Translation tests. One long writing test. End of Module Assessment (w/b 26 th April 2021) Based on Modules 4-5 (Listening and Translation)
Summer 2	Revision/Mocks and Cultural Learning	Revising all key aspects from Modules 1-5 and preparing students for the Speaking exam.	Vocabulary test every fortnight. Grammar tests. Translation tests. End of Year exams (w/b 14th June 2021 for 3 weeks) Listening Reading Writing Speaking
