

## KS4 CURRICULUM: SPANISH (YEAR 11)

**Overview**  
 In Spanish you will learn about: Year 11 Spanish takes into account prior learning and continues deepening students language skills at KS4. You will learn to understand longer and passages on familiar themes and learn to use the Present continuous and Present Subjunctive tenses whilst revisiting the use of regular and some irregular verbs in tenses studied in Year 10 but using them all together in order to access Grades 4+. Students will be developing their Speaking and Writing skills to a higher level than used before. They will also be developing their cultural awareness through the various Modules studied at GCSE and have the chance to speak about these in their Speaking assessments.

Also discussing healthy lifestyles and sports. <b>Using the present subjunctive, the imperfect continuous and the pluperfect tense.</b> <b>Understanding different tenses in one text.</b>	Vocabulary test every fortnight. Grammar tests. Translation tests. One long writing test.
Spring 2	Assessment week Revision and preparation for the Speaking exam.	Students will be doing revision for the May exams and preparing for their speaking exams which take place straight after the Easter holidays.	Vocabulary test every fortnight. Grammar tests.
