

KS5 CURRICULUM: SPANISH (YEAR 12)

Overview: Year 12 students will build on the knowledge, understanding and skills gained at GCSE. They will explore trends and issues of the Spanish speaking society with a focus on language, culture and society. It fosters a range of transferable skills including communication, critical thinking, research skills and creativity, which are valuable to the individual and society. They will also extend their cultural knowledge through literary texts.

Autumn 2	Cyberspace	Discuss the positive and/or negative influence of the Internet. Use the present and the present continuous Use comparatives and superlatives	Assessment week (w/b 9th Nov 2020)
Spring 1	Equal rights	Discuss women in the world of work and study the role of women at home. Discuss male chauvinism and understand and talk about changes to LGBT rights. Use the future perfect and the conditional perfect	End of module assessment (w/b 5th Jan 2021)
Spring 2	Modern day idols	Discuss the positive and/or negative influence singers and musicians have on people Discuss the positive and/or negative effect TV and cinema stars have in our society Use direct and indirect object pronouns	Assessment week (w/b 22nd Feb 2021)
Summer 1	Spanish regional identity	Describe and discuss Spanish customs and traditions Consider the languages that are spoken in Spain and the issues surrounding them Use the present subjunctive of regular verbs	End of module Assessment (w/b 19th April 2021)
Summer 2	Cultural heritage	Understand civilisations that contributed to the cultural heritage of Spain Understand and use efficiently demonstrative and possessive adjectives	End of Year exams (w/b 14th Jun 2021)
