Home Learning Guidance Year 11

It has been amazing to have all the students back in school and engaging with their learning. I have been overwhelmingly impressed with the focus and work ethic that I have seen from the year group since returning from the summer break. I am extremely proud of how far this year group have come and how they continue to mature into successful young adults. Keeping your child and rest of the community safe has been at the heart of all we do. I am sorry, therefore, that due to the impact of Covid-19 on students or teaching staff we have regrettably had to close your son or daughter's bubble.

We haven't taken this decision lightly. We have been working with Public Health England and the Department for Education to ensure we are following all recommendations and legal framework when there is a positive case at Chace.

It is imperative that we try and keep students in a structured routine so they can learn just as effectively at home. The year group's timetable is below which they should follow as normal, we will be using Google Meet and for virtual live online lessons following their normal timetable for next week starting with Period 1 on Monday at 8.30. Registrations will begin on Tuesday morning. Students can access the lessons via Google Classroom.

Registration/Form Time and all lessons are compulsory and more details of these will follow, during this lockdown period. We will be monitoring attendance as normal and are working within the adapted attendance guidelines. We will be following our normal absence procedures if students are not attending registration and lessons. Morning Registration/Form time and assemblies

A timely start of the day is essential; therefore the day starts with a short registration with their form tutor from Tuesday morning at 8.20. This is to ensure that students are up in time and to answer any questions first thing in the morning. This will allow students to get into their first lesson on time and be ready for the day ahead.

Assemblies play an important part of the week for wider topics and to educate our students beyond the national curriculum. These assemblies will now however be either pre-recorded or live. It is essential that students attend these or watch the recordings before the end of the week.
